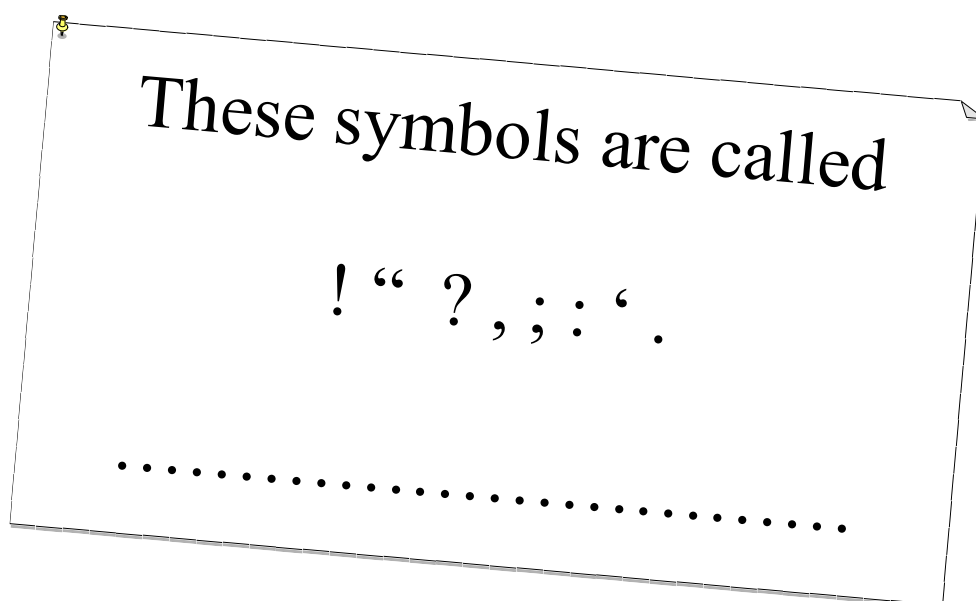


# Capital Letters
